- Q. No-44 . -** Non-metals generally form acidic oxides while some of its oxides are neutral eg. H<sub>2</sub>O, N<sub>2</sub>O, NO, CO. Therefore, the correct answer is option D.
- Q. No-58 . -** Less than one tonne of coal is needed to produce one tonne of steel. Hence the correct answer is option E .
- Q. No-61 . -** Dibang and Lohit are left bank tributaries of River Brahmaputra. River Brahmaputra emerges from the foothills in the name of Dihang and is not a tributary. Hence the correct answer is option B.

- Q.No. 04-** The evidence cited by the examinee does not mention the same words as in the Quotation in the Question.
- Q.No. 09-** The German word *Arbeiterpartei* in English literally means 'Workers party'. This original German name was never Changed.
- Q.No. 11-** Evidence cited by the examinee is not duly supported by exact reference. Hence the correct answer is option 'A'.
- Q.No. 19-** The Ahmedabad Textile Labour Association was established by Mahatma Gandhi, but not in 1918. Hence the correct answer is option 'E'.
- Q.No. 23-** Japan surrendered on 14-08-1945 (U.S. Date )
- Q.No. 32-** Surya Sen was the revolutionary who believed that compassion is the special quality of a revolutionary.

### **Part-III (Economics)**

- Q.No. 16-** (a) When we take previous year (2018-2019) to show percentage increase per annum, then Annual growth rate is 6.77. (Refer to page no-96, table no-3.13, Economic Survey -2020-2021)  
(b) When we take Compound Annual growth rate given in the Bihar Economic Survey (2020-2021) (Refer to page no-96, table no-3.13) then it is 6.07.  
(c) None of these are mentioned in the given options.  
So the correct answer is option 'E' (None of the above)
- Q.No. 26-** As per the given report by the government of India, Ministry of Commerce and Industry, Department of Commerce, Option B is correct. India stands at second Place in the world in 2022 in the production of rice and wheat.

### **Part-III (Political Science)**

- Q.No.02-** All three option A, B & C are subject of Local Govt., therefore option (A) is not correct (source- option A , B & C have been mentioned in the 12th schedule, directly and indirectly both in The Constitution of India).

- Q.No.06-** In the year 1994 Manmohan Singh was the Finance minister and not the Prime Minister. As a finance Minister in 1994, he introduced the Service tax. Therefore the question is deleted.
- Q.No. 10-** Promotion of the spirit of brotherhood is contained in the part (IV)-A under Fundamental Duties (Art. 51A(e)), therefore option A, B and C are not correct answer. Hence the correct answer is option 'E'.
- Q.No. 11-** "Preamble is the key to the Indian constitution" has not been said by the persons mentioned in option A, B and C. Hence the correct answer is option 'E'.
- Q.No. 24-** The option A, B and C are also correct because Erode Venkatappa Ramasamy is known for all these names. Hence the correct answer is option 'D'.
- Q.No. 35-** Social security is related to Economic Right and not Natural Right and Cultural Right. It is clearly mentioned in Art. 9 in "The International Covenant on Economic, Social and Cultural Rights (ICESCR) and Art. 22 in UDHR 1948. Hence the correct answer is option 'C'.
